

Curriculum Summary for Autumn 2 2025: Year 1 & 2

Core Christian Value: Respect

English:

Writing through the Drawing Club approach. Sharing different stories weekly, expanding our vocabulary and letting our imagination help develop our creative writing skills.

Verbs, nouns, adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions.

Capital letters, full stops, commas in a list

Adjectives, expanded noun phrases.

Spelling patterns/Phonics and reading comprehension.

PSHE:

Celebrating differences. Exploring friendships and what a good friendship is. Discussing bullying.



Maths:

Addition & Subtraction; number bonds, links between addition and subtraction number sentences, identifying missing numbers, counting on and back in 1s and 10s.

Shape: Recognising and naming 2D and 3D shape, exploring features - vertices, edge. Symmetry. Pattern.

DT:

Investigating vehicles. Designing and creating vehicles with a chassis, wheels and axles.

Science: Uses and properties of everyday materials. Practical experiments into which materials are used for specific purposes and why. Exploring and describing properties.

Musical devices

Nativity: Prickly Hay

Computing:

Programming and moving a robot.

Command functions using floor robots.

History:

Guy Fawkes and his role in the Gunpowder Plot

Religious Education:

Why does **Christmas** matter to Christians? (incarnation)
Christmas Church Service.

Forest School: Tuesday PM

Appropriate clothing (layers, waterproofs and footwear) is essential. Children should wear school uniform and bring their kit in a bag to change into.

Reading Books: Changed Tuesday & Friday

Please encourage your child to revisit their books. This helps to develop fluency and understanding of a text.

Physical Education:

All children will need PE kits for **Mondays** and **Wednesdays** (rugby). On a Monday they will need to wear school uniform to school and change in school ready for their lesson. On a Wednesday they may wear PE kit to school. All school uniform and PE kit **MUST** be named.
