Review and Plans September 2023 - July 2024 (with reviews through the year)

Headlines 2022-2023

Pupil Premium Grant

- 4 children were entitled to the PPG grant during 2022-23
- The school received funding of £5,820
- This funding was used to support individual children and their families. It covered the cost of trips, visits, extended schools provision and additional learning.

Post Looked After Children

- 3 children, across 2 families received Post Looked After funding during 2022-2023.
- The total allocation of funding received last year was £7,590
- This funding was used to support individual children by covering the cost of additional extra-curricular activities.

Headlines 2023-2024

Pupil Premium Grant (FSM)

- 3 pupils are currently entitled to the PPG (FSM) funding this year
- During 2023-2024 a total amount of £5,820 was allocated (£1,455 per child)
- The total cost of funding received by the school includes Ever 6 funding for one child (Year 6 leaver)

Post Looked After Children

- 3 children across 2 families are currently identified as Post LAC
- During 2023-2024 a total amount of £7,590 funding has been received (£2,530 per child)
- Individual Plans have been created through partnership work with each family to support children's individual needs. These plans help to measure the accountability and effectiveness of how the PPG funding is used and its impact.
- The school's co-ordinator for Pupil Premium children and Post Looked After Children is Miss Sarah L. Hindle.
- The school's link governor for Pupil Premium children and Post Looked After children is Rev. Julie James. Meetings are held to monitor provision throughout the year.
