1. National Curriculum Subject Leadership

Teachers and link governors will effectively monitor their National Curriculum subject areas to show a positive impact across the whole school. This work will include book looks, teaching and learning observations, a collection of pupil views and progress measures.

2. Curriculum Development and Quality of Teaching and Learning in Religious Education

Each class teacher will implement and deliver high quality R.E. teaching and learning using the objectives and planning from the new R.E. Worcestershire Agreed Syllabus (September 2025-2030).

3. Quality of Teaching and Learning in Writing

Close monitoring of whole school writing provision. This will include regular book looks, teaching and learning observations, a collection of pupil views and data to ensure pupils make at least good progress in relation to their age-related expectations from Reception to Year 6.

4. Personal Development – Reflexes

Through research and regular specific exercises, children's reflexes will develop and improve over time. The impact of this work should show an improvement in children's movement, their co-ordination, to include handwriting skills and general focus.
