Autumn Term 2 Tuesday 5th December 2023 at 2:40pm

- We reviewed the points and actions from our last meeting. Monitors are now established in their roles and new rules have been shared around football and sports for outdoor break/lunchtimes with opportunities for both boys and girls.
- The posters for the litter project would be shared in next Monday's assembly (11th December). Some of the group had already made a start with their designs.
- Several more ideas were shared for future consideration. These included exploring the opportunity for Class 4 to use the outdoor classroom at times. (Fr)
- The idea of a twice weekly lunchtime 'Doodle Club' to support drawing for a small number of 6 younger children was shared. (Fr and another child had offered to help with this.)
- The Pupil Governors were keen to organise a fund-raising project during the year. Pupil views could be sought to decide on the charity we would like to support. Ideas from the group included, WWT, Red Cross or Clean Water in Africa. The thought of arranging a mini marathon around the running track with participation from everyone was suggested.
- Following a Governors' meeting with Miss Hindle, we were interested to seek opportunities which could bring both the Governing Body and our Pupil Governors together. The group were interested in finding out more about the roles of our Governors. A hand written letter will be compiled which Miss Hindle will pass onto the Governing Body. We will try and arrange a visit from a member of the Governing Body to meet with the school council. Their current litter picking project ideas could also be shared.
- Now we have re-designed the space in the previous library area for more group work, the Pupil Governors would like to collect the children's views to choose a name for the room. The suggestions of the 'LIFE room, The Little Room and the Room of Learning were shared as a starting point for these discussions.

Actions

- Write a letter from the group to the Governing Body
- Meet with a member(s) of the Governing Body to learn more about their roles in school and to share the work of the school council (litter picking project).
- Collect the pupils' ideas to re-name the previous library space/room

Future Actions

- Consider introducing a twice weekly 'Doodle Club' at lunchtimes
- Decide on the charity we will support for a funding raising event in the summer term.
