- Miss Hindle congratulated the new Pupil Governors on their appointments for the new school year.
- The role and purpose of our Pupil Governor meetings was explained.
- Each Pupil Governor had the opportunity to share their own ideas and talk about the ways they would like us to explore these. We focused on the ideas which the group felt would bring the most benefit to all of the children as part of school improvement in making Eldersfield Lawn the best it can be.

Ideas were shared from the group which included:

1. **Litter picking** -encourage everyone to be tidier. 3 children volunteered to help monitor this for us.
2. Remind all children about the **Buddy bench** and how the Key Stage 1 Monitors are there to support the younger children at breaktimes whenever needed.
3. Older children to continue helping the younger children, again through the **Monitoring roles** which have been established this year.
4. Seek the views for the sports choices/games to interest girls during lunchtimes.
5. Collect ideas and views from children in Class 4 around lunchtime football games which provide opportunities for both boys and girls.
6. Sports Monitors to check the footballs are pumped up.

After some discussion, the group decided they would like to focus on keeping our playground spaces tidy and to encourage everyone to dispose of litter carefully in the bins provided.

Actions

To help achieve this area of improvement, the Pupil Governors will:

- Design and make posters which they will share and display as reminders for everyone (complete by mid November)
- Share the litter picking project with everyone in assembly time (mid November after the posters have been completed).
