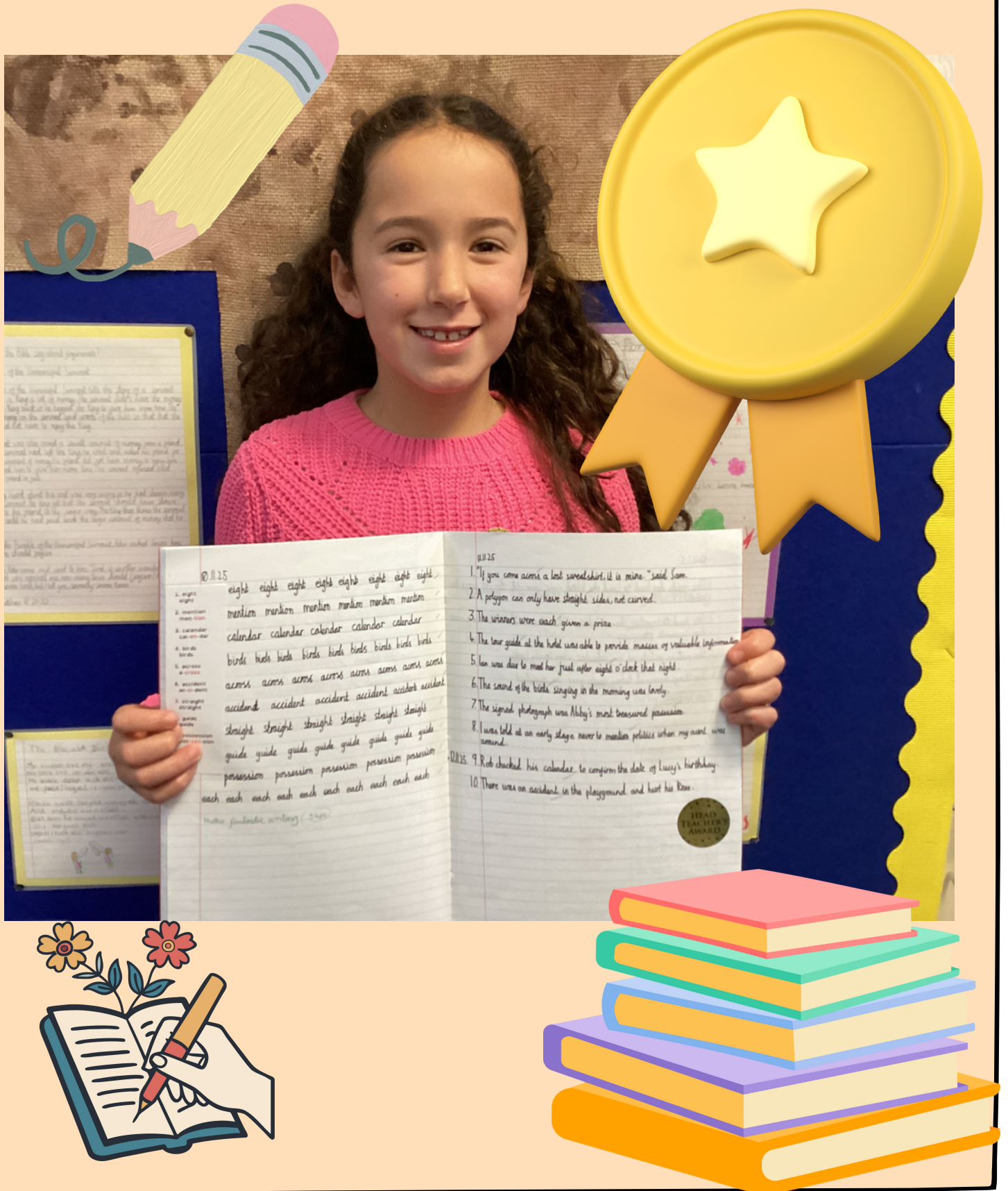

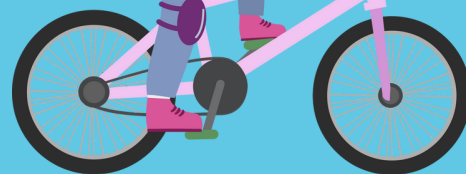
Excellent Work
