Class 2 - The pupils are learning about the artist Kandinsky and creating their own artwork.

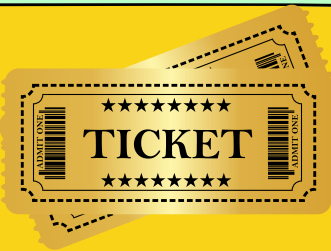
Class 3 - The pupils have been researching the architecture of historical buildings as part of their topic.

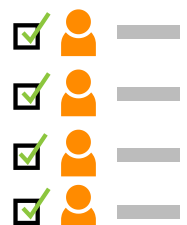
