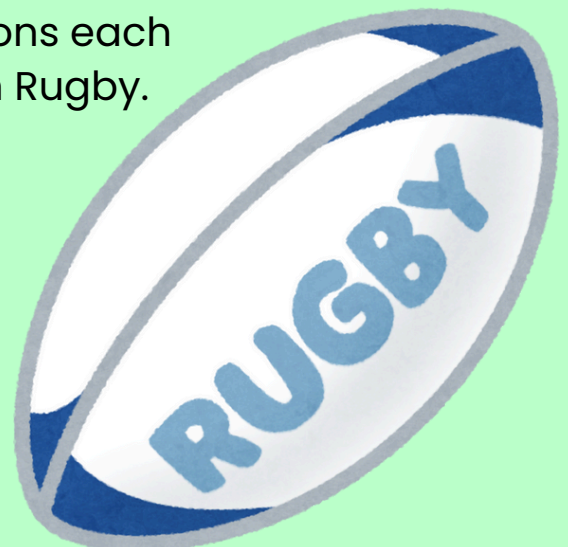
Parking Reminder

We would also be grateful of some flat wooden scaffolding planks for our Forest School area (around 5-6 would be ideal). Thank you for any help you may be able to offer.

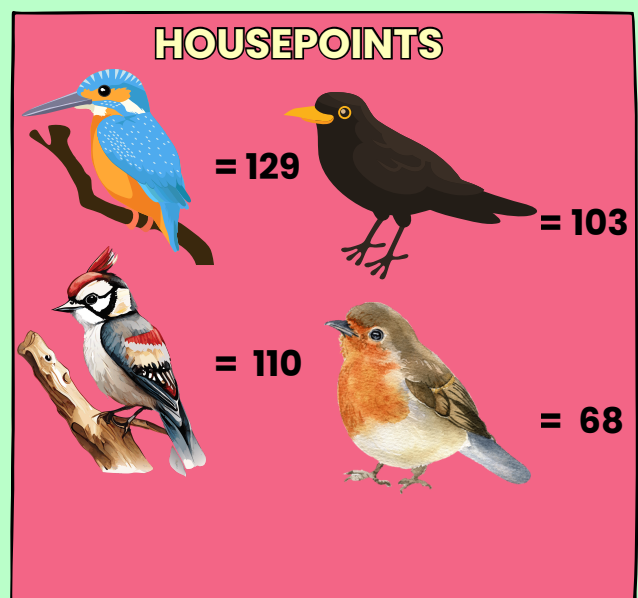
CLASSROOM NEWS HIGHLIGHTS

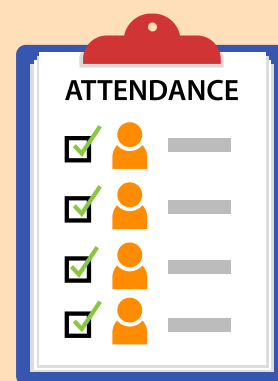

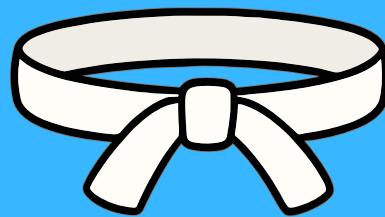

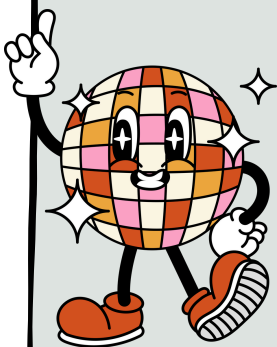
