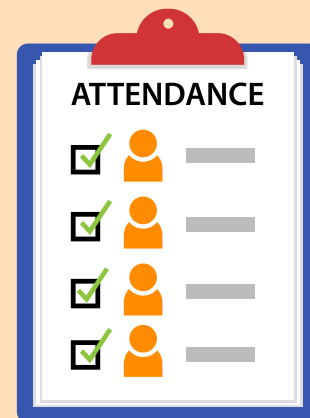

With the Ball – Indoor Athletics After School Club

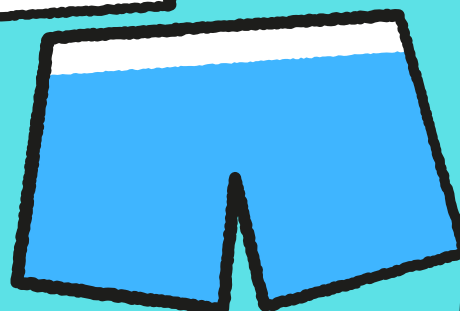
To ensure the Monday Indoor Athletics Club can continue to run, we need more pupils or unfortunately it will have to be cancelled.

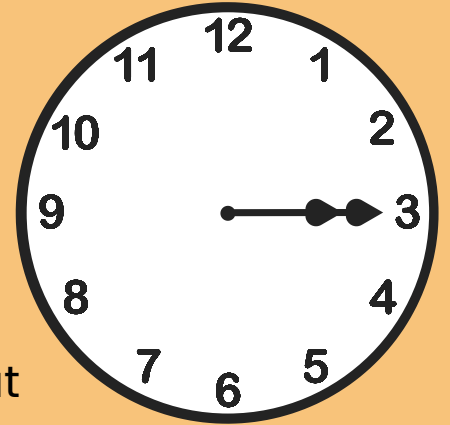
