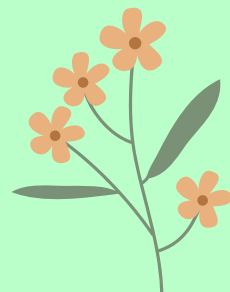
A huge congratulations to this cohort on their SATs results too! This year, 100% of our Year 6 pupils achieved the expected standard in Reading and Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation and 93.8% in Maths.

The overall results at the greater depth standard were also very impressive, with 50% of children achieving this level in Reading, 18.8% in GSP and 31.3% in Maths. This provided an overall combined result at the expected standard of 87.5% and 12.5% at greater depth. Fantastic achievements everyone!

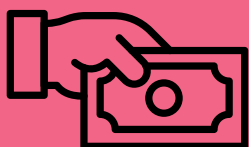
