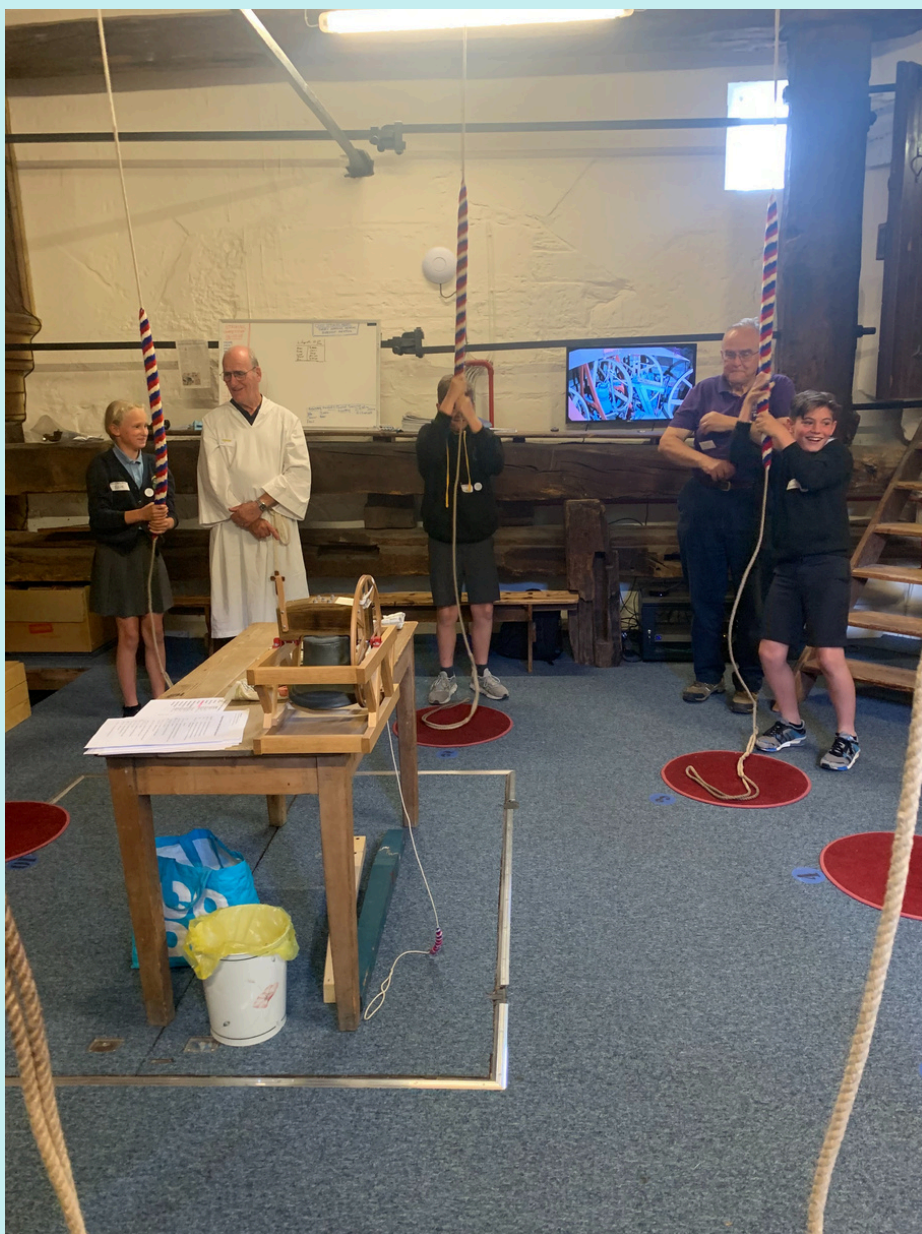
SPORTS DAY HOUSEPOINTS

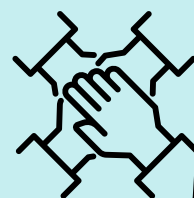
