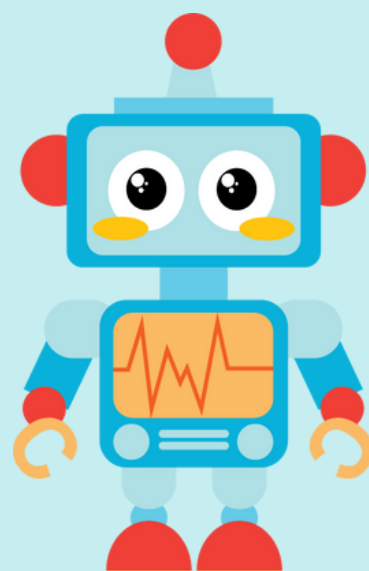
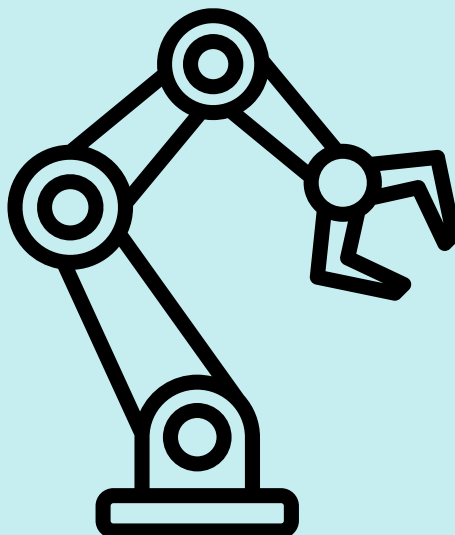

SPORT NEWS

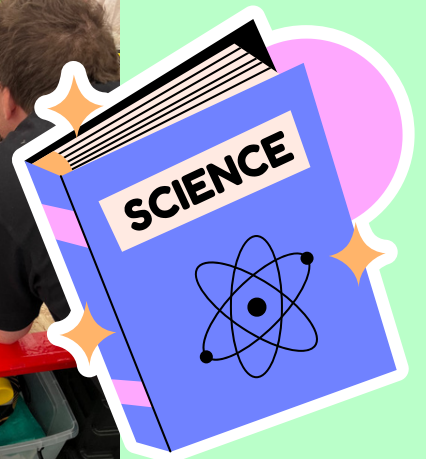
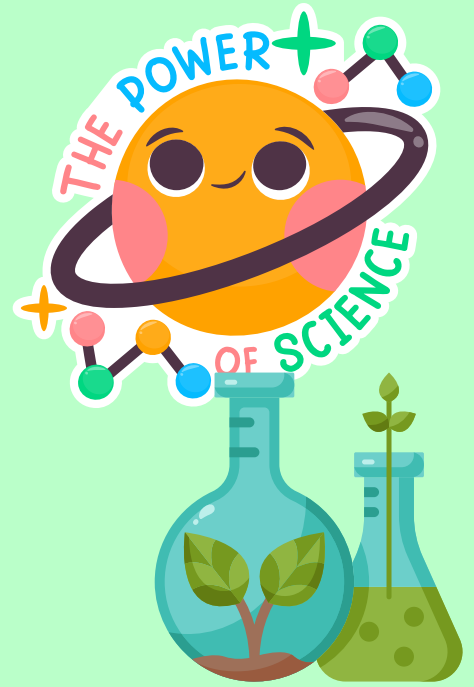
Josh B attended the British Freestyle Wrestling Championships.

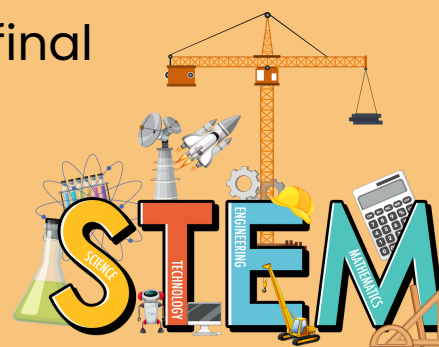
