We are working behind the scenes to try to improve the parking and road safety situation, but in the meantime it would be great to get us all working together to ensure we are driving and parking as safely as we can.

Please follow the speed limit during drop off and pick up times. This is 20MPH.

When parking don't leave big gaps between vehicles meaning less people can fit along the designated parking bays.

If parking in the non-designated parking areas, be considerate to the local community and don't park close to the junction edge. (Linkend Rd)

If you see parents and children waiting to cross please slow and if safe to do so stop to let them cross.
