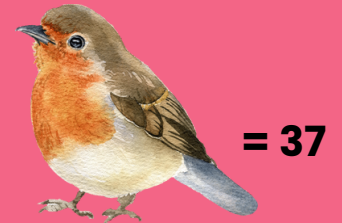

Girls Football Festival

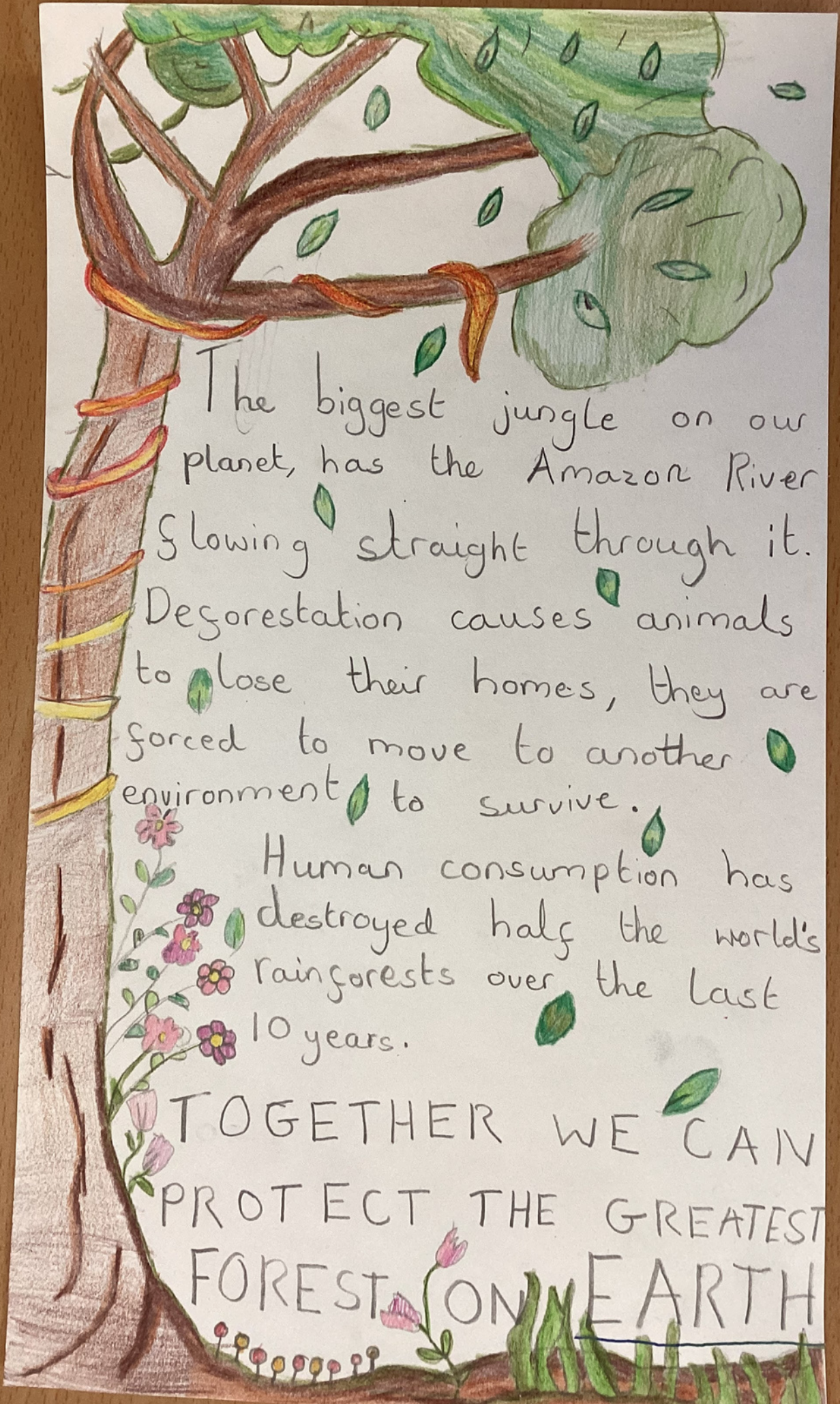

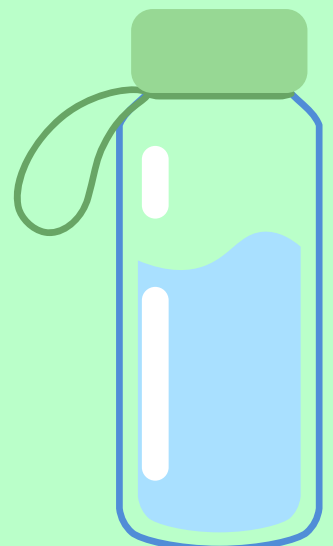


SCHOOL EASTER SERVICE @ ELDERSFIELD CHURCH 10TH APRIL

- Please remember to bring your child's water bottle into school.

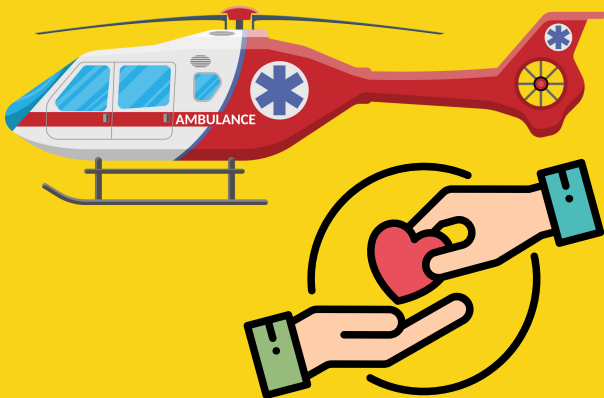
