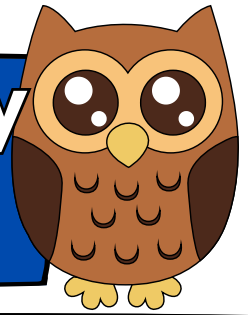

Class 2 - The pupils have been practising their creative writing skills producing poems about arctic animals in English.

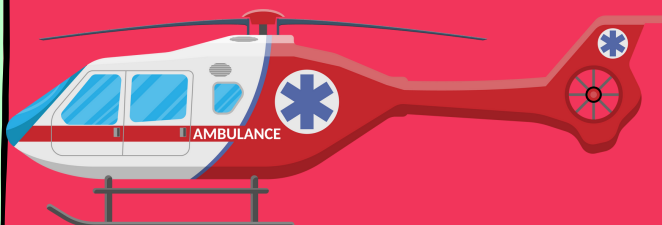
Class 3 - The pupils have been conducting a condensation experiment in Science and learning about life in Roman Britain.
