School Carol Service (please read)

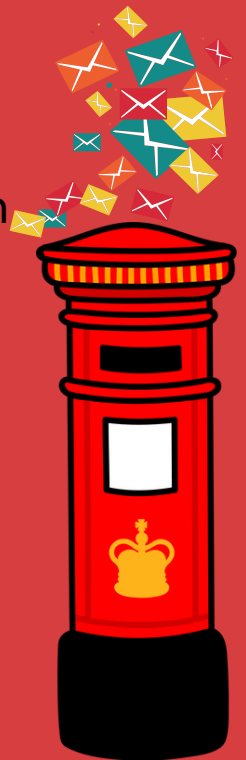
