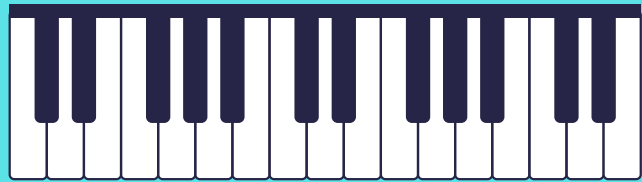

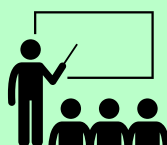
Christmas Fayre 29th Nov 5-7pm
