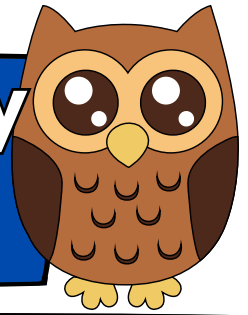

CLASS 4 TRIP TO RAF DEFFORD

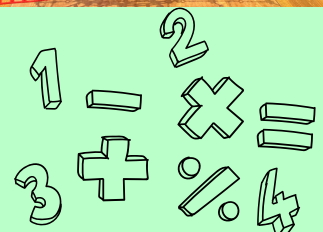
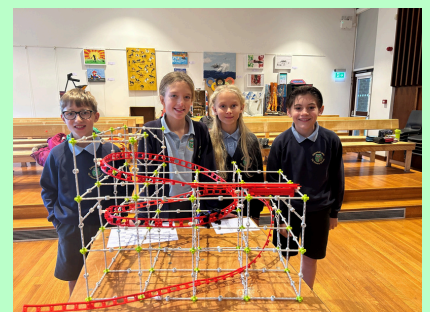


Class 4 have visited RAF Defford today to learn about the fascinating role that RAF Defford played during World War II.
