More details to follow nearer the time.

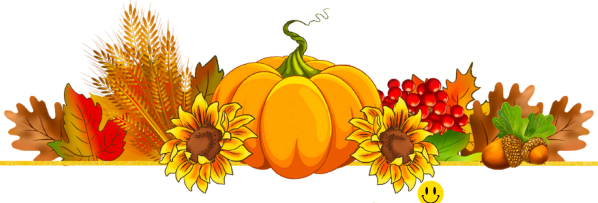

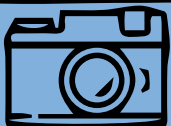
