We wish you all a wonderful half-term until our return on Monday 23rd February!

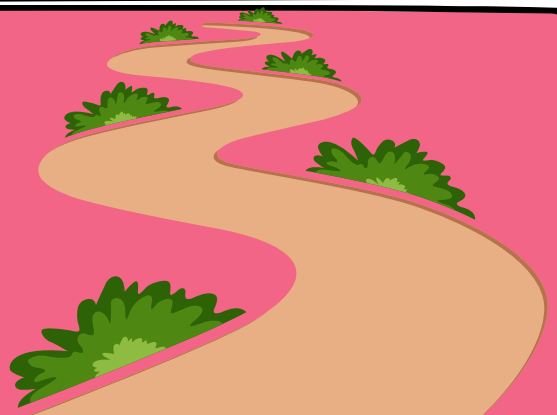
Class 4 French Cafe

Class 2 - The class have been creating their own monsters and writing similes.

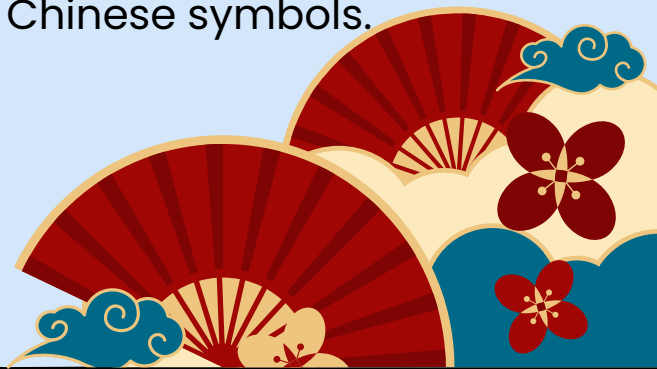
Class 3 - The class have been looking at buildings and different designs. In Maths they have been learning fractions.

Children's Mental Health Week

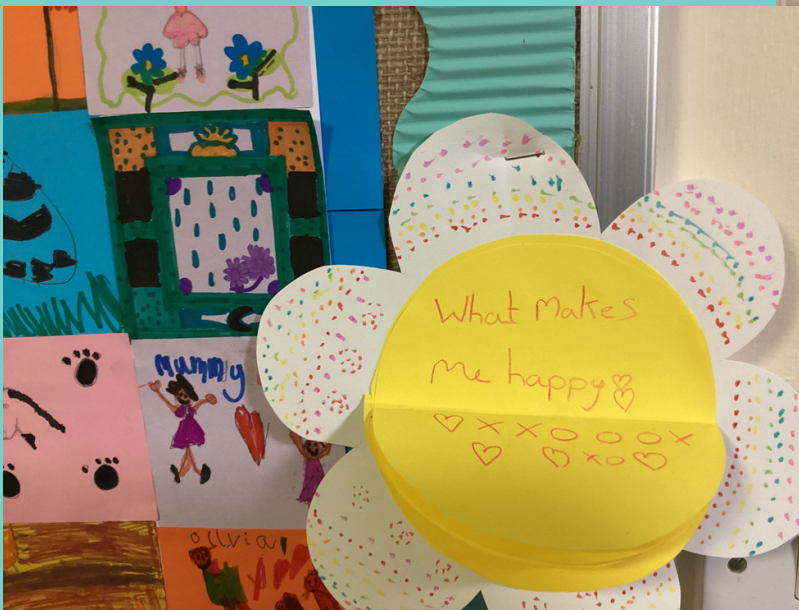
The pupils thoroughly enjoyed all of the activities provided for Children's Mental Health Week at school.

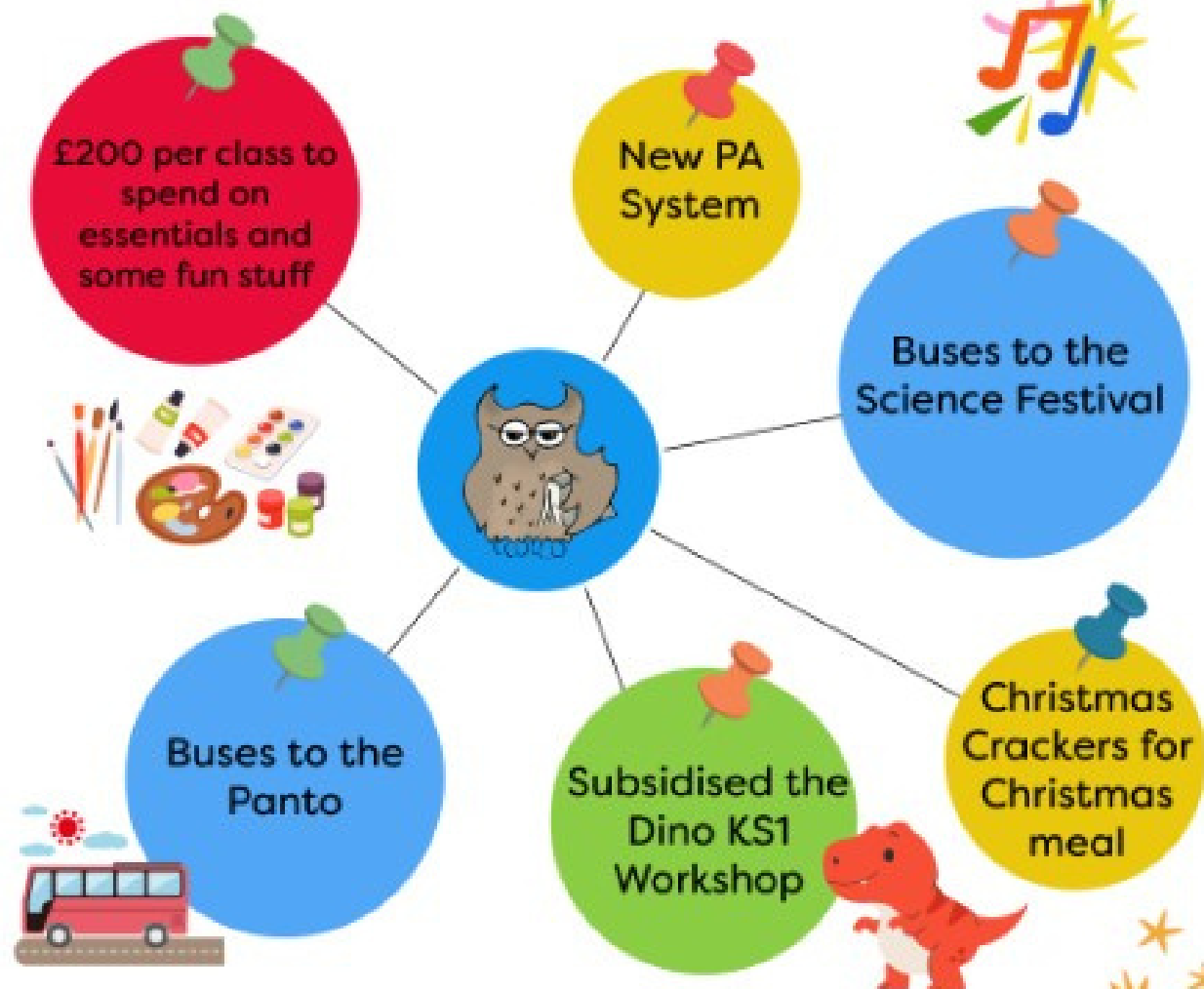
