MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Parent Forum

The Parent Forum will be meeting on Friday 13th. Thank you for sharing your views via the parent year group representatives and for the work involved in collating the views. Jenny Blades and I have looked through the items raised in readiness for this meeting.

To provide you with a few updates:

- I have met with a representative from the Parish Council to strongly share our road safety concerns. This resulted in the Parish Council including road safety as an item on their agenda at their recent meeting. They are in full support of working with us to continue exploring improvements on the road with the highways team and the community support officers. Spot visits from the community support officers have also been requested again as a way of catching drivers who exceed the speed limits. We will keep you posted with progress.
- Children have been reminded to stay on the hard core areas of the playground and other outdoor spaces while the weather is so wet to try and reduce muddy footwear and uniform.
- Uniform is looking smarter! Thank you for your support with this. We kept the uniform the same as before and just to add, that navy tights are fine to wear too.

- We love the idea of playing music as the children enter school in the mornings! I recently watched a news article about this and we're all in favour of bringing music, movement and positivity to the start of the school day! The PTFA have kindly purchased a new PA system, so hopefully we can be playing different styles of music soon to welcome you all into school in the mornings (this may be weather dependant at times).
- We're delighted to hear that the open afternoons for current parents are being really well received by providing the opportunity for your child to share their learning/books with you. The next date for the open afternoon will be on Thursday 12th March 2.00-4.30pm to provide plenty of notice for parents. A third date will also be arranged during the summer term.
- Healthy snacks are something we would like to see more of for children's health benefits and to link with recent healthy schools work too. We will share our thoughts and collect views around this area at the next Parent Forum meeting.

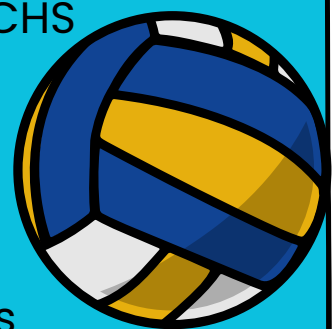


School lunches for after half term are now available to book on ParentPay. To ensure your child has a school meal the first week back after half term please book by Wednesday 11th Feb.
